



Auckland Pride Event Registration Terms & Conditions

These Terms & Conditions (“Terms”) apply to all events registered as part of the Auckland Pride Queer Agenda (“Auckland Pride”, “API”, “Queer Agenda”, “we”, “our”, or “us”).

By registering an event, you agree to the following Terms.

1. Event Registration

By submitting your event, you confirm that:

- The information you provide is accurate and up to date.
- You have permission and authority to run the event.
- Your event complies with relevant laws, regulations, and venue requirements.
- Your event aligns with Auckland Pride’s values and kaupapa.

Submitting an event does not guarantee inclusion in the Queer Agenda. Auckland Pride reserves the right to accept, decline, or remove events at its discretion.

2. Registration Fees

Auckland Pride Members

- Free events & events at Proud Centres: FREE
- Ticketed events up to \$30: FREE
- Ticketed events above \$30: \$30

Non-Members / Community Groups / Collectives

- Ticketed events up to \$30: \$30
- Ticketed events above \$30: \$50

All fees are in NZD and may include GST where applicable.

Registration fees must be paid by the due date provided by Auckland Pride.



3. Event Changes & Cancellations

You must notify Auckland Pride as soon as possible if your event is:

- Cancelled
- Postponed
- Sold out
- Significantly changed

This helps us keep festival listings and communications accurate.

Registration fees are generally non-refundable if an event is cancelled for reasons within the organiser's control.

If an event is cancelled due to circumstances outside your reasonable control (such as extreme weather or emergencies), Auckland Pride may waive or refund fees at its discretion.

4. Event Information & Listings

Event organisers are responsible for keeping event information accurate and up to date, including:

- Dates and times
- Venue details
- Ticketing links
- Accessibility information
- Pricing
- Content warnings
- Contact information

Updates should be submitted through the registration platform or emailed to Auckland Pride staff.

Approved events will be listed on Auckland Pride platforms within a reasonable timeframe.

5. Marketing & Promotion

API will list registered events on the Auckland Pride website within 3 working days of completed event registration.

API may promote your event through Auckland Pride channels, including:

- The Auckland Pride website
- Facebook
- Instagram
- TikTok
- Bi-monthly "What's On" EDMs/newsletters



Social media promotion may include grouped posts by category or venue, or inclusion in “What’s On” posts and stories.

For greater visibility, organisers are encouraged to tag @AucklandPride as a collaborator on Instagram posts and stories promoting their event so we can accept the collaboration and/or share the content to our Story.

Where time and capacity allow, Auckland Pride may also support additional promotional opportunities for registered events.

6. Complimentary Tickets

For paid ticketed events, organisers agree to provide up to two complimentary tickets for Auckland Pride representatives, subject to availability.

These may be used for staff, reviewers, media, stakeholders, or promotional purposes.

7. Event Organiser Responsibilities

Event organisers are responsible for all aspects of their event, including:

- Planning and delivery
- Venue hire and compliance
- Staffing and contractors
- Ticketing and finances
- Insurance
- Audience management
- Accessibility
- Permits, licences, and performance rights
- Health and safety compliance

Auckland Pride is not responsible for the delivery, operation, financial outcome, or success of registered events.

8. Values & Inclusion

To participate in the Auckland Pride Festival, organisers must support Auckland Pride’s kaupapa and values, including:

- Honouring Te Tiriti o Waitangi
- Supporting and celebrating Takatāpui, MVPFAFF+, and Rainbow communities
- Creating inclusive, accessible, and welcoming events
- Encouraging participation, creativity, and connection across our communities

Auckland Pride may remove events or organisers whose actions are inconsistent with these values.



9. Photography, Video & Intellectual Property

Event organisers retain ownership of their event content and branding.

By registering an event, you give Auckland Pride permission to:

- Use event images and promotional materials you provide
- Capture photos and video at your event where appropriate
- Use this content to promote current and future Auckland Pride Festivals

You confirm that you have the rights and permissions required for any content shared with Auckland Pride.

10. Post-Event Reporting

Event organisers may be asked to provide post-event information, including:

- Attendance numbers
- Audience feedback
- Accessibility outcomes
- Images or documentation
- General feedback about participating in the Festival

This information may be used for reporting, advocacy, funding applications, and future festival planning.

11. Liability

Event organisers participate in the Festival at their own risk.

To the extent permitted by law:

- Auckland Pride is not liable for losses, damages, injuries, cancellations, or financial outcomes relating to registered events.
- Each party remains responsible for its own staff, contractors, audiences, and activities.

12. Removal of Events

Auckland Pride may remove or cancel an event registration if:

- These Terms are breached
- Fees remain unpaid
- The event no longer aligns with Auckland Pride values or policies
- The event creates legal, reputational, or safety concerns



Where appropriate, Auckland Pride may provide an opportunity to resolve issues before removal.

13. General

These Terms are governed by the laws of New Zealand.

Auckland Pride may update these Terms from time to time.

Participation in the Auckland Pride Festival does not create a partnership, employment, or agency relationship between Auckland Pride and event organisers.

By registering your event, you confirm that you have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms & Conditions.
