Auckland Pride is seeking a dynamic and creative Digital Producer to join our team. The Digital Producer will be responsible for developing and managing digital content that tells our story, builds a meaningful archive, enhances our presence, engages our community, and supports our advocacy and event initiatives. This role requires a strategic thinker with strong technical skills and a passion for storytelling within our Takatāpui and Rainbow Communities.

As this is a newly established role within the organisation, the responsibilities outlined may shift as the role is embedded into the organisation. The expectation is that the Digital Producer will be flexible with this process and be prepared to get involved in every area of the organisation.

Ngā Whetū: Our Goals

Key goals for the role are to:

- Contribute to a workplace that is professional and positively reflects the values of the organisation within the work.
- Develop the unique kawekawe (culture) of the organisation to create a positive experience for the Auckland Pride artists within our Owned Programme, Te Tīmatanga, Pride Elevates & Pride Connects and Open Access Artists.
- Ensure Auckland Pride's initiatives and pursuits are informed from a story-telling and archival lens from the outset.
- Ensure a streamlined Online & In-Person Festival Registration Process, and the successful delivery of the Auckland Pride Print Programme.
- Work with key Creative, Publicity & Media Partners to ensure streamlined communications.

Key Responsibilities

Content Creation and Management:

- Produce, and manage high-quality digital content across multiple platforms including social media, website, email newsletters and print.
- Collaborate with our Creative and Media Partners to ensure consistent messaging and branding.
- Oversee the production of multimedia content including videos, graphics, podcasts and articles.
- Manage the Queer Agenda, off season event calendar and relevant promotional materials and initiatives.

Digital Strategy:

- Build a comprehensive digital strategy that aligns with Auckland Pride's mission, vision, values and goals.
- Analyse digital trends and audience insights to optimise content and engagement.
- Manage and grow Auckland Pride's membership through innovative digital campaigns.
- Deepen and grow Auckland Pride's relationship with our partners, through stronger story-telling and key initiatives.

Event Support:

- Provide digital support for Auckland Pride Owned Programmes and Open Access events, including live streaming, event promotion, and post-event content.
- Coordinate with the Executive Producer and Event Organisers to create digital content that enhances the overall event experience.
- Ensure the legibility and comprehension of Festival Programmes.

Community Engagement:

- Foster a vibrant online community by engaging with followers, responding to inquiries, and facilitating discussions.
- Lead and Direct creative shoots and initiatives, ensuring that our artists feel supported, understood and seen.
- Implement initiatives to increase participation and representation of underrepresented groups in our digital spaces.
